

Educational objectives 1st degree

The aim of educational activities for students in the first degree of higher education is to prepare them in the field of Health Sciences in the study programme Physiotherapy to perform independent activities requiring professional erudition, independence at work, decision-making, personal responsibility in physiotherapy and medical rehabilitation, prevention, primary, secondary, tertiary and follow-up health care.

Other goals of the educational process are education and training of independence in the diagnosis and treatment of musculoskeletal disorders and other related diseases in rehabilitation departments, outpatient centres, spa, fitness studies, nursing care agencies and others.

The aim of the education is to prepare physiotherapists to perform the medical profession. The graduate can perform pedagogical activities at the relevant degree of education in the field. They will acquire practical skills and methodological knowledge in the key areas of physiotherapy at the synthesis level, which serve as a basis for practice and research. He/she is able and entitled to independently perform the range of activities in the profession that are given by the chosen completed study programme.

The aim of the bachelor's degree is to prepare the student for further university, specialization and continuing education.

Training for the profession is carried out in accordance with the relevant European and national legal standards.
