Educational objectives 2nd degree

Graduate

• The graduate of the 2nd degree of the study program in physiotherapy is a qualified higher education healthcare professional with a broad professional profile. The graduate is ready to independently carry out activities requiring expert knowledge, autonomy in work and decision-making, bears personal responsibility in physiotherapy and therapeutic rehabilitation, in prevention, in primary, secondary, tertiary and follow-up health care.

• Graduates can independently perform methodological and analytical work, participate in program development, and are expected to have the ability for active, conceptual, and creative activities, such as the creation of application programs, teaching methods analysis, designing and participating in research, management and administrative work in public and private sector.

• The graduate defines, plans out and performs highly specialized techniques, methodologies, physiotherapeutic procedures, balneological procedures, hydrotherapy, ergotherapy and electrotherapy in all clinical disciplines such as neurology, orthopaedy, surgery, traumatology, gynaecology, internal medicine and paediatrics.

• Graduates master the basics ergotherapy, robotic rehabilitation, virtual rehabilitation, telerehabilitation, the fundamentals of sports for people with disabilities, special kinesiology and pathokinesiology.

• The graduate mastered basic methodologies and management of physiotherapy, in healthcare organizations, insurance, and in the public sector.

• A characteristic feature of the graduate is a deep, moral-ethical, and humane approach to people, especially the sick and physically disadvantaged. They can express empathy, and give comfort and emotional support, considers the patients' personality, their perception of health, illness, physical disability, their experience, and behaviour under the influence of changes in their health status, win them over and motivate them to cooperate.

• The graduate has the prerequisites for independent scientific research and methodological-organizational work in the field, creatively participates in the development of the field and pedagogical-scientific activities.

• In the field of education, the graduate is prepared to participate in the educational and training programmes for physiotherapists for the performance of the medical profession. The graduate may carry out pedagogical activities at the relevant levels of education in the field. The graduate has practical skills and methodological knowledge in the key area of physiotherapy at the synthesis level, which serves as a basis for practice and research.

He/she is capable and authorized to independently perform the range of activities in the profession that are defined by the chosen completed study programme.

• The graduate has the prerequisites for further university studies of the III. degree, further specialization and continuation of the education. Preparation for professional practice is carried out in accordance with the relevant European and national legislation.
